

## Erratum

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In the report “Post-Acute Sequelae of SARS-CoV-2 Infection Among Adults Aged  $\geq 18$  Years — Long Beach, California, April 1–December 10, 2020,” on page 1276, in the first full paragraph the first sentence should have read, “In the **multivariable** regression model, the odds of experiencing symptoms 2 months after a positive SARS-CoV-2 test result were significantly higher among females (aOR = 2.83), persons with at least one preexisting condition (aOR = 2.17), and those aged 40–54 years (versus 25–39 years) (aOR = 1.86) (Table 3).”
